



2017 XTERRA EUROPEAN TOUR RULES FOR ELITES/PROFESSIONALS

Step 1: Race and Score – Enter as many races as you want and score points by finishing in the top 15 of the elite field. There are four 100-point scale “Gold” races and the remainder are 75-point scale “Silver” races. The season is from April-to-September.

Gold races: Switzerland, France, Germany, Denmark

Silver races: Malta, Cyprus, Greece, Spain, Portugal, Belgium, Finland, Abruzzo, Norway, Poland, Sweden

Step 2: Most Points Win - The male and female elite athlete with the most points at the end of the season earns the title of XTERRA European Tour Champion and earns \$2,500 in Tour bonus money. If there is a tie in points, the tie-breaker will be the person with the most wins. If still tied after counting wins, the person finishing highest in the most recent race where both competed. If no head-to-head exists, tie-breaker goes to the person finishing highest in the most recent race.

2017 XTERRA European Championship: It is not necessary for elites to qualify to race at the XTERRA European Championship, which will double as the XTERRA Denmark Championship on September 3 at Mons Klint. This is a one day award as opposed to the Tour title which counts all races. In Denmark, the top overall male/female elite finisher, regardless of nationality, will be honored as the XTERRA European Champion. The top Danish male/female elite will be named the XTERRA Denmark Champion.

Silver races offer the equivalent of \$7,500 USD in prize money to the top five men/women. Gold events offer the equivalent of \$15,000 USD to the top seven men/women. The European Championship race in Denmark will offer \$25,000 USD for the race and distribute an additional \$20,000 USD to the top 10 men/women in the final XTERRA European Tour rankings. The exact amount of Euros will be based on currency exchange on Feb. 1, 2017.
