

WELCOME TO OAHU

HAWAIIAN is a beautiful language, but not easy to pronounce. The race venue is about 40 minutes from Waikiki. Here's advice on how to get around our island. First and foremost, learn how to pronounce a couple of the streets and roads you will use.

LIKELIKE is pronounced Leek-ay Leek-ay
KAHEKILI is pronounced Kah -heh- keel-ay
KUALOA is pronounced Koo-ah-low-ah

Race registration, packet pickup, gear sales at the gorgeous Waikiki Beach Walk mall on Lewers Street.

WAIKIKI AND GETTING OUT OF TOWN

If you are in Waikiki at one of the Outrigger or Ohana hotels:
The main drag is Kalakaua Ave (ka-la-cow-ah) and is one way.
Head EAST on Kalakaua
Turn left on Kapahulu (cap-a-hoo-loo) at the end of hotel row where the zoo is
Stay on Kapahulu to the end and follow signs to H1 west

HOW TO GET TO KUALOA RANCH

Take the H-1 Freeway west to the LIKELIKE Highway / Route 63. Proceed up the LIKELIKE Highway through the Wilson Tunnel. Descend towards Kaneohe town and

- Exit onto KAHEKILI Highway / Route 83, heading north. Go straight through the light at the end of the KAHEKILI exit.
- Continue along Kahekili Highway -

Note Kahekili Hwy becomes Kamehameha Highway as you pass a gas station on your right.

- In about 10 minutes you will see signs indicating you're approaching Kualoa Ranch entrance on your left.
- Go past the main entrance and make your next left into the XTERRA festivities.
