2019 XTERRA EUROPEAN TOUR RULES FOR ELITES

Step 1: Race and Score – Enter as many races as you want and score points by finishing in the top 15 of the elite field. There are four 100-point scale “Gold” races and the remainder are 75-point scale “Silver” races. The season is from April to September.

Gold: France, Italy-Scanno, Czech, Germany

Silver: Cyprus, Greece, Malta, Italy-Garda, Portugal, Belgium, Denmark, Switzerland, Poland, Netherlands, Luxembourg

Step 2: Count 50% of your races, plus one. If 15 races on Tour, your best 8 scores count, regardless if gold or silver.

Note: The XTERRA European Championship counts as one of your 8 scoring events, regardless if you race or not.

Step 3: Most Points Win - The male and female elite athlete with the most points at the end of the season earns the title of XTERRA European Tour Champion. If there is a tie in points, the tie-breaker will be the person with the most wins. If still tied after counting wins, the person finishing highest in the most recent race where both competed. If no head-to-head exists, tie-breaker goes to the person finishing highest in the most recent race.

2019 XTERRA European Championship: It is not necessary to qualify, nor be European, to race at the XTERRA European Championship on August 3 in Prachatice. This is a one-day award as opposed to the Tour Championship which counts an elites’ best eight scores.

In Czech, the top three elite men and women, regardless of nationality, will be given medals on the podium at the XTERRA European Championship awards ceremony. We will also recognize the top three Europeans in situations where a non-European athlete earned a podium spot. The top European man/woman will be declared the XTERRA European Champion. If a non-European wins the race, he/she is honored as the XTERRA European Championship race winner.

Top 10 Free Entry Rule: Elite men and women ranked in the top 10 of the final 2018 XTERRA European Tour standings are eligible for free entry into the first seven races of 2019 events and must declare their races and register prior to the start of the season. Athletes ranked in the top 10 in Tour standings after XTERRA Denmark will be eligible for free race entries for the remainder of the 2019 season and must declare their races and register prior to June 23, 2019.

Prize Money: Silver races offer the equivalent of \$7,500 USD in prize money to the top five men/women. Gold events offer the equivalent of \$15,000 USD to the top seven men/women. The European Championship race in Czech will offer \$25,000 USD for the race. An additional \$20,000 USD will be distributed to the top 10 men/women in the final XTERRA European Tour rankings. The exact amount of Euros will be based on currency exchange on Feb. 1, 2019.
