2020 XTERRA AMERICA TOUR RULES FOR AMATEURS

The XTERRA America Tour is designed to provide age group athletes with bona-fide championship titles to compete for. The racing season spans from February thru September and at the end of the season, title contenders from across the country face off at the XTERRA USA Championship in a race for both national & tour championship crowns.

Here's how the Tour works:

1) **DETERMINE YOUR DIVISION/AGE GROUP:** How old you are on December 31, 2020 determines your age group. There are divisions for men and women 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70+ (w), 70-74 (m), 75-79 (m), 80+ (m), and Physically Challenged.

2) **RACE AND SCORE:** Enter as many races as you want and score points by finishing in the top 15 of your age group. There are three 100-point scale races (Oak Mountain, Beaver Creek, and USA Champs) and the remainder are 75-point scale races. Athletes can earn more points at 100-point races because, generally, participation is higher, and the courses are tougher. **Note:** If an athlete races at both Oak Mountain and Beaver Creek, only their best finish counts at 100-point level. The other finish earns points at the same rate as a 75-point scale race.

3) **HOW TO WIN THE TOUR:** To win the XTERRA America Tour title add up your best two scores during the regular season plus what you score at the USA Championship race (regardless if you race or not). Those three races will determine your final points score and the athlete with the most points - by gender and age group - earns the title of XTERRA America Tour Champion, an exclusive XTERRA America Tour Champion racing jersey, and a qualifying spot into their choice of the 2020 or 2021 World Championship. **Note:** Max points is 275. Example: Earn 100 points for a win at XTERRA Oak Mountain or Beaver Creek + 75 points for a win at any other regular season race + 100 points for a win at the USA Championship.

4) **MANDATORY:** You must race *and place* in at least two XTERRA events to be eligible for XTERRA America Tour honors and you must count your score from the USA Championship as one of your three scoring races, regardless if you race or not.

5) TIE BREAKER: If there is a tie in points, the tie-breaker will be the person with the most 1st place finishes in their age group from their three scoring races. If still tied after counting wins, the person finishing highest in the most recent race where both competed. If no head-to-head exists, tie-breaker goes to the person finishing highest in the most recent race.

6) PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED ATHLETES: Physically Challenged athletes may choose to compete in the XTERRA Physically Challenged male/female Open Division or in XTERRA age group divisions. PC athletes must choose whether to race in the PC Open or age group division at their first race of the season and remain in that category for the entire year. There are no PC age group divisions (15-19, 20-24, etc.) or disability categories (PT1, PT2, etc.). All other rules above apply.

7) QUALIFYING FOR XTERRA WORLDS: Maui slots will be awarded to XTERRA American Tour Champions at the end of the season and at every XTERRA American Tour event as follows:

75-point scale events will award 26 Maui slots:

- One to the first-place person in each age group noted below.
- These slots do not roll, unless the age group winner already earned a slot and registered for Maui.

100-point scale events - Oak Mountain, Beaver Creek, USA Champs - will award 51 Maui slots:

- Slots will roll down among the top 8 until filled.

Note: Races held on and after September 1 qualify athletes for their choice of a 2020 or 2021 World Championship slot.
 - PC athletes who race at least one XTERRA during the season will earn a qualifying slot to Maui.
