



2017 XTERRA PAN AMERICA TOUR RULES FOR ELITES/PROFESSIONALS

Step 1: Race and Score – Enter as many races as you want and score points by finishing in the top 15 of the elite field. There are six 75-point scale “Silver” races, three 100-point scale “Gold” races, and one 200-point scale “Double Gold” race. The season is from March-to-September.

Silver races: Argentina, Chile, Costa Rica, Brazil, Victoria, Dominican Republic

Step 2: Most Points Win - The male and female elite athlete with the most points at the end of the season earns the title of XTERRA Pan Am Pro Series Champion and earns \$10,000 in Tour bonus money. If there is a tie in points, the tie-breaker will be the person with the most wins. If still tied after counting wins, the tie-breaker goes to the racer who finished highest in the most recent race where both competed. If no head-to-head exists, the tie-breaker goes to the person finishing highest in the most recent race.

2017 XTERRA Pan America Championship: It is not necessary for elites to qualify to race at the XTERRA Pan America Championship, which will double as the XTERRA USA Championship on September 16 in Ogden, Utah. This is a one day award as opposed to the Tour title which counts all races. In Utah, the top overall male/female elite finisher, regardless of nationality, will be honored as the XTERRA Pan America Champion. The top American male/female elite will be named the XTERRA USA Champion.

Silver races offer the equivalent of \$7,500 USD in elite prize money to the top five men and women. Gold events offer the equivalent of \$15,000 USD in elite prize money to the top seven men and women. The XTERRA Pan America Championship race in Utah will offer \$20,000 USD for the race and distribute an additional \$60,000 USD in prize money to the top 10 men and women in the final XTERRA Pan Am Pro Series rankings.
